



Historical and intellectual roots

- Alexander von Humboldt (1769–1859): discoverer, universal scholar, cosmopolitan and patron of excellent scientific talent
- 1953: establishment of today's Alexander von Humboldt Foundation based in Bonn Bad-Godesberg
- international network of academic cooperation and trust inspired by Humboldt's example

Principles of the Foundation

- sole selection criterion: academic excellence
- no quotas for countries or disciplines
- sponsorship of people, not projects
- free choice of research topic and of academic host/collaborative partner in Germany
- equal opportunities for female academics
- fellowship extension or interruption, allowances for childcare

Capes-Humboldt Research Fellowship



	Postdoctoral researchers	Experienced researchers
Duration of sponsorship	• 6 to 24 months	6 to 18 months, may be divided up into 3 stays
Application period	• 2 calls each year, doctorates completed less than 4 years ago	 2 calls each year, doctorates completed less than 12 years ago
Fellowship amount	 € 2,600 per month (plus additional benefits) 	 € 3,100 per month (plus additional benefits)

→ 188 Capes-Humboldt Research Fellowships granted so far

Unfortunately, at present, it is not possible to apply for a Capes-Humboldt Research Fellowship. Instead, postdocs and experienced researchers from Brazil who are interested in spending time working on research in Germany can apply for a Humboldt Research Fellowship or – if they are conducting development-related research – for a Georg Forster Research Fellowship.

International Climate Protection Fellowships

for prospective leaders from transition and developing countries, who

- are engaged in climate protection;
- are working in non-governmental organizations, public administrations, politics, academia or business;
- would like to conduct an independent project agreed with a host in Germany
- until now, 7 fellowships granted to climate experts from Brazil

German Chancellor Fellowships

for outstanding prospective leaders from Brazil, China, India, the Russian Federation and the USA

- from a broad range of areas such as politics and public policy,
 law, media, business, the non-governmental sector, and the arts
- with an independent project in Germany that has been agreed with the host.
- intermediaries between their home countries and Germany
